

RURAL NORTH CAROLINA AT A GLANCE

Rural North Carolina is made up of 80 counties out of the State's 100. This is based on the Rural Center's analysis of county population density with data from the 2010 decennial


The classification system adopted by the Rural Center uses a county population density threshold of 250 people per square mile or less to define counties as "rural."


